Vietnamese group wins Japonica rice export contracts to RoK

Vietnam Plus: 30/May/2018

Vietnam: Vietnam's Tan Long Group has won three contracts to sell 50,000 tonnes of Japonica rice to Korea Agro-Fisheries & Food Trade Corp of the Republic of Korea, 70 percent of the bidding volume.

Tan Long has entered the rice export market in recent years. Its rice processing plant is located in Lap Vo district in the Mekong Delta province of Dong Thap with capacity to 180,000 to 200,000 tones of rice per year. Read more

Final edible stock sale okayed

Bangkok Post: 05/June/2018

Thailand: The government has approved the sale of the final edible-grade rice stocks totalling 43,700 tonnes with a value of 534 million baht to nine bidders after postponing the auction for almost a year. The lots includes 24,000 tonnes of 5% white rice, 7,000 tonnes of 100% hom mali and 6,000 tonnes of provincial fragrant rice. The remaining rice comprises glutinous rice, broken white rice and broken hom mali rice. Adul Chotinisakorn, director-general of the Foreign Trade Department, said Prime Minister Prayut Chan-o-cha, chairing the Rice Policy and Management Committee, approved the sale and selected nine of the 35 bidders. The winners will sign a contract with the Public Warehouse Organization and the Marketing Organization for Farmers within 15 official working days. Read more

Thai, Singapore firms bag deal to supply 250,000 MT of rice

Philippine: State-run National Food Authority (NFA) has awarded the supply contract for 250,000 metric tons (MT) of rice to four companies from Thailand and one from Singapore to boost the country's limited buffer stock.

NFA recently issued the notice of award to the suppliers who will be required to post a performance bond in the next

Bangladesh reintroduces 28% tax on rice imports

Bangladesh: The duty on locally produced starches, wheat, maize, potato and cassava, has also been rationalised to 15 percent customs duty and 10 percent regulatory duty.

Bangladesh's rice output from the summer crop is likely to hit 19.7 million tonnes against the target of 19 million tonnes, Mohammad Mohsin, director general of the Department of Agricultural Extension, told Reuters in May. Read more

Vietnam rice exports to China drop

Rice imported by Indonesia during the first four months went up 333 times over the same period last year, Iraqi imports increased by over 16 times, that of Malaysia tripled, of Hong Kong increased 41.5 percent and that of Singapore,15.7 percent. 
