(Reservoir expected to increase agro-production)

Preah Vihear authorities have been building a reservoir at a cost of over \$100 million to supply water for agricultural rice crops during the dry season.

Speaking at a press conference in Phnom Penh, Preah Vihear provincial deputy governor Kousom Bunsoeut said Prime Minister Hun Sen provided about \$110 million for the construction of the reservoir in stimulating agricultural production in Preah Vihear province. (Read more)

Cambodia has exported 356,097 tonnes of milled rice to foreign markets during the first five months of this year.

DAKAR — In ordinary times, it takes Boureima Diawara two or three days to truck his mangoes the 1,200 km (745 miles) from southern Mali to Senegal's seaside capital Dakar.

But since coronavirus restrictions came in, some shipments have taken more than twice as long. After struggling with border delays and a dawn-to-dusk curfew in Senegal, Diawara's workers have ending up dumping sacks of rotten fruit in landfill. (Read more)

THE country's rice imports are expected to reach only about 1.8 million metric tons (MT) for the current market year (MY), the Samahang Industriya ng Agrikultura (Sinag) said, refuting the US Department of Agriculture's (USDA) earlier projection of at least 3.3 million MT.

"Contrary to the USDA-projected rice imports of 3.3 million tons, we estimated that for MY 20/21, rice imports will only reach about 1.8 million metric tons,".... (Read more)


