# Ministry to begin \$20M plan for domestic vegetables

Phnom Penh Post: 02/June/2017

**Cambodia** - Implementation of a previously announced three-year \$20 million programme to increase local vegetable and fragrant rice production will begin next month to help boost domestic supply and reduce imports, an agriculture official said yesterday.

The goal of the project is to increase local production of vegetables by 160 tonnes per day and production of 500,000 tonnes of paddy rice a year, Kean Sophea, deputy director of the Department of Horticulture and Subsidiary Crops at the Agricultural Ministry, said. *Read more*

#### Coarse rice price soars

**Bangladesh** - Prices of coarse rice, mostly consumed by the poor and people of lower-middle income groups, went up 42 percent since June last year.

Even though the private sector imported one lakh tonne of rice during that time, paying 25 percent import duty, the price of a kg of coarse rice was Tk 45-46 this week. In the first week of June 2016, it was Tk 30-34 a kg.

Though prices of finer and medium quality rice varieties registered 9 to 20 percent rise during the same period, price hike of coarse rice was worrying the government. *Read more*

# Why price of local rice is high – Rice millers

**Nigeria** - Rice millers in Kano State have attributed the high cost of locally-produced rice to the increasing cost of production of the commodity in the country.

Mr Liman Muhammed, spokesperson, Medium and Small Scale Rice Millers Association in the state, said this during a visit to some rice mills in Kano on Wednesday.

The price of 50kg locally-produced rice ranges between N20,000 and N22,000 while that of imported rice is between N12,000 and N15,000. *Read more* 



### Rice farmers encouraged to plant maize after harvests

**Thailand** - Agriculture Minister Chatchai Sarikalya said on Monday that, from his discussion with representatives of the animal feed manufacturers' association, it was learned that animal feed producers need between 7-8 million tonnes of maize year as raw material to produce animal feed. Of the 7-8 million tonnes of maize needed for the industry, half of them came from legitimate farmland the rest came from high-land plantations on land which was used to be covered with forest but which was destroyed and encroached. *Read more*

### Rice supply critical by end June – NFA

**Philippine** - The National Food Authority (NFA) warned that rice stocks in government-owned warehouses will be critically low by the end of June if the country will not start the importation process in the next few days.

The agency said that by the end of the month, rice stocks will only be good for two days.

Under the law, the NFA should have at least a 15-day buffer stock at any given time, and 30-day buffer stock during the lean months. *Read more*

# Vietnam's top export products in five months

**Vietnam** - Wood and timber products, rice, coffee, cashew nuts and vegetables and fruits, each with a value of more than US\$1 billion, are top export products in the first five months of this year, according to the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development. *Read more* 



Rice exports reached 538,000 tons with a value of US\$245 million in May, bringing the total rice exports in five months to 2.3 million tons valuing US\$1 billion, up 1.6% in volume and 1.2% in value.

## Mekong Delta's winter-spring rice output falls

**Vietnam** - The Mekong Delta region has completed harvesting this year's winter-spring rice crop, with the total output reaching 9.62 million tonnes, down 361,000 tonnes as compared to the same crop last year.

According to the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, diseases and unfavourable weather were blamed for the drop in the rice output.

The strongest falls were seen in Dong Thap province (166,000 tonnes), Long An (96,500 tonnes), Can Tho city (59,100 tonnes), and Kien Giang (50,000 tonnes). *Read more* 



#### Asia Rice-Thai prices hit near 4-year high on strong demand from importing countries

**Thailand** - Thailand's benchmark 5-percent broken rice RI-THBKN5-P1 was quoted at \$440-\$457 a tonne, free-on-board (FOB) Bangkok, up from \$430 last week.

Thai prices have been rising steadily since March, when traders started loading ships, and reached a level unseen since August 2013 this week.

"Ships are still arriving and exporters are buying supply to fulfil shipments," said a trader in Bangkok. *Read more*

# Thailand sells 1.66 mln T of rice from state stockpiles

**Thailand** - Thailand sold 1.66 million tonnes of rice worth \$49 million from state stockpiles on Wednesday, the commerce ministry said.

The amount sold accounted for 90 percent of the amount open for auction last month.

Thailand is the world's second-biggest rice exporter after India, and still has stocks of about 3 million tonnes left over from the previous government's rice-buying scheme, which paid farmers well above market rates. *Read more* 

## Most edible rice in old stockpile now sold

**Thailand** - The National Rice Policy Committee has approved the 16.56billionbaht sale of 1.66 million tonnes of old rice to auction winners, leaving only 160,000

tonnes of edible rice in the stockpile.

Duangporn Rodphaya, directorgeneral of the Foreign Trade Department, said on Wednesday the committee endorsed the sale of the rice that 24 bidders won in the second auction of old government rice this year, on May 24. Read more



#### Rice storage offers price security

**Cambodia** - Rice millers can expect a certain degree of price stability in their exports with the construction of a 200,000-tonne capacity rice warehouse and a 3,000-tonne silo facility in Battambang province.

The silo is expected to be finished by the end of the year and the warehouse will be fully operational for the 2018 harvest season, according to the CEO of the Cambodia Rice Bank. *Read more* 



## New export markets boost rice sales

Myammar - Although international rice prices are low, exports of rice have increased. Last year, we could export to only 14 countries but now we have extended it to 30 countries. We gained a greater market share and, at the same time, more rice can be exported this year. From border trade, nearly US\$40 million more was earned than in previous years. Previously the main route was Muse but we have other routes such as Lweje, Chin Shwe Haw and Kanpaiktee now. We increased sales to Bangladesh from the Maungdaw and Sittwe camps," said an anonymous official from the Trade Department. Read more



# Vietnam's rice export price hits 3-year high

**Vietnam** - According to the Ministry of Industry and Trade, the demand for Vietnam 5% broken rice has been rising, hitting US\$390 per tonne in the first days of June, against US\$360 - US\$380 per tonne in late May.

This is the highest price since December 2014, the ministry said, attributing it to the rising global demand for rice imports, especially in the Asian region. *Read more*

Replying to the issue raised by CT Ravi (BJP) in the legislative assembly on Friday, health minister KR Ramesh Kumarsaid: "Food experts and scientists have ruled out plastic rice or eggs. Since reports keep surfacing in the media, we have ordered an inquiry. We will ascertain if these are a fallout of gossip or if there is any truth." Read more


